I should mention our altar decorators & banner hangers, greeters & ushers, welcome center & security team, and so many others who generously give their time & talents to do ministry together at Faith. Together we make a beautiful team. Together, we do the work of "bringing people to Jesus Christ through worship, education, mission, and fellowship."

Staffing Transition

In July 2021, Faith will experience staffing transitions. Pastor Caitlyn will be reappointed to Palos United Methodist Church and First United Methodist Church of Evergreen Park. I encourage you to express your appreciation and well-wishes for Pastor Caitlyn in the coming months.

Many of you have asked what will happen next. Will we receive a new associate pastor on July 1? The answer is "no." Back in 2019, our congregation voted on a staff reconfiguration plan. Based on our **Strategic Goals**, we approved a plan to replace our associate pastor position with 3 specialized ministry positions: **Youth Ministry, AV Ministry, and Congregational Care**. We shared our plans with the Northern Illinois Conference Bishop and Cabinet, who gave us a green light to move forward with our staffing transitions.

At the present time, our **Staff Pastor Parish Relations Committee** is hard at work creating job descriptions and interviewing candidates for these positions. Let's lift them up in prayer as they prepare our staff team for the future.

Stewardship Update

The Stewardship Committee would like to thank all of our members for their past and continued support of Maintain Faith. A few years ago our Trustees noted a concern that a few major capital expenses may be coming up in the near future. We decided at that time to reach out to the congregation to start a Maintain Faith account to be used to cover these expenses. We were hoping to build up enough capital in this account so that we wouldn't have to borrow funds or hold several Capital Campaigns to cover these costs. As of now, we have been able to use those funds in 2019 to pay \$120,789.50 for rooftop HVAC units, \$92,410 for sanctuary lighting, and \$10,750 for parking lot repairs. Last year we used \$10,210.04 to replace our fire alarm system. As you can see, your funds have been well spent. There are still projects that will come up, so we need your continued support. If all of our members were to contribute just \$25/month to Maintain Faith, we could add \$50k/year to our fund. That will go a long way to helping us maintain our beautiful building




Drive-In Communion



Save the Date: Friday to Sunday, 9/17-9/19, Northern Illinois Conference UMM Spiritual Congress at Williams Bay, WI.





Updated Reopening Guidelines April 12, 2021



Immediate Changes:

- Eliminate taking temperatures to enter church
- Resume regular numbers allowed in bathrooms
- Allow congregation to recite The Lord's Prayer orally
- Allow congregation to exit sanctuary using social distancing without dismissal by an usher (would allow use of north sanctuary door to exit to hallway)

Changes when IL reaches "Bridge" (70% of residents 65 and older have been vaccinated and barring any reversals in our COVID-10 hospitalizations and deaths for a 28 day monitoring period)

- Open entire sanctuary (still social distancing)
- Allow 60% capacity in building at 1 time

Changes when IL reaches Phase 5 (50% of residents 16 and older have been vaccinated and stable or declining COVID-19 metrics are recorded during a 28-day monitoring period)

- Masks will not be mandated but will be encouraged to be worn
- Removal of 6 foot social distancing requirements – entire building
- Eliminate preregistration for church attendance
- Allow shared food (resume Taste of Faith and funeral luncheons)
- Reopen drinking fountains
- Resume choir
- Allow congregational singing

Misc.

- Sunday School – Resume at the earliest in the fall of 2021. Revisit the reopening in August. Must have reached Bridge phase.
- Nursery- Resume at the earliest in the fall of 2021. Revisit the reopening in August. Must have reached Bridge phase. Attendants must wear masks. Attendants must be fully vaccinated. No snacks will be served.
- Continue to park in every other spot.
- Staff and church volunteers who are fully vaccinated do not have to quarantine if they are exposed to COVID-19.

Pastoral Emergency Fund

Background: Faith currently has a designated fund that provides bill assistance and gift cards to our neighbors who express need. Foreseeing the economic repercussions for our neighbors who receive hourly wages and are unable to work for two weeks, we are anticipating a significant increase in assistance requests. By donating to the Pastoral Emergency Fund, your resources will be used by Faith's pastors to assist with bill payments and gift card assistance.

Or, in the memo line of the check write Pastoral Emergency Fund - Gift Cards if you would like for your donation to be used to purchase gift cards for assistance.

You will be credited on your giving statements for donations to the Pastor Emergency Fund.

Blood Drive




